

I purchased this text for my son who is taking Sociology 141 this year. Unfortunately, it has been rendered useless in its current format. Although every other e-book, Kindle format or otherwise, I've ever gotten was able to be viewed on both the app and the reader program, for some reason this book is supposedly not compatible with the computer based Kindle reader. When my son went to download the book it did not give an option to download to the Kindle reader app already installed on his Chromebook, it showed that is was not available in that format. I double checked to see from a different computer, just to be sure, and it still showed that it could not be downloaded to the PC app. It can be viewed from the mobile Kindle app, so if you're ok with trying to read a college textbook on your phone screen, or if you already have a Kindle tablet, then proceed. Know that my son tried reading it on his phone, and found that it was more of a hinderance to the learning experience than a help. So after spending over \$150 on this book in its current format and the supplement to it that he needed, I will be purchasing it again in a different format from another source.
